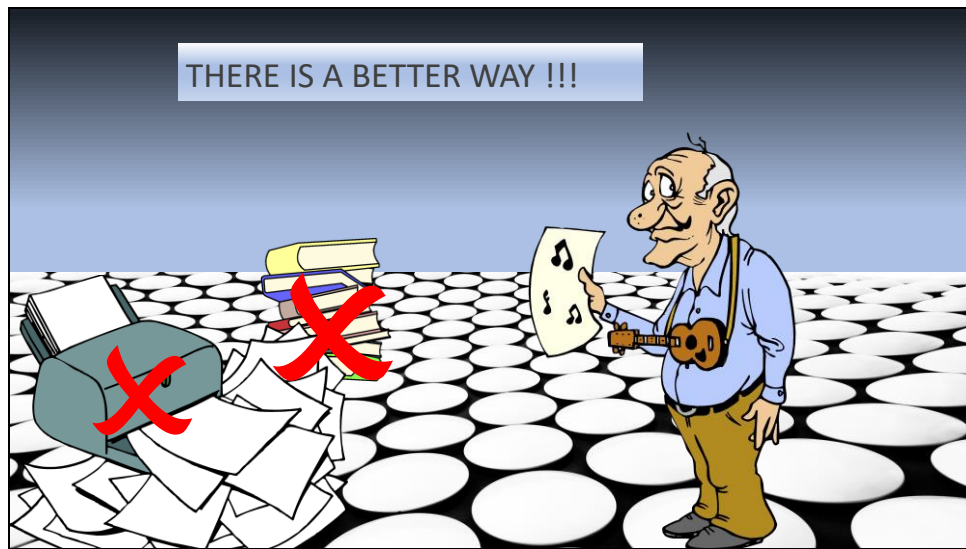

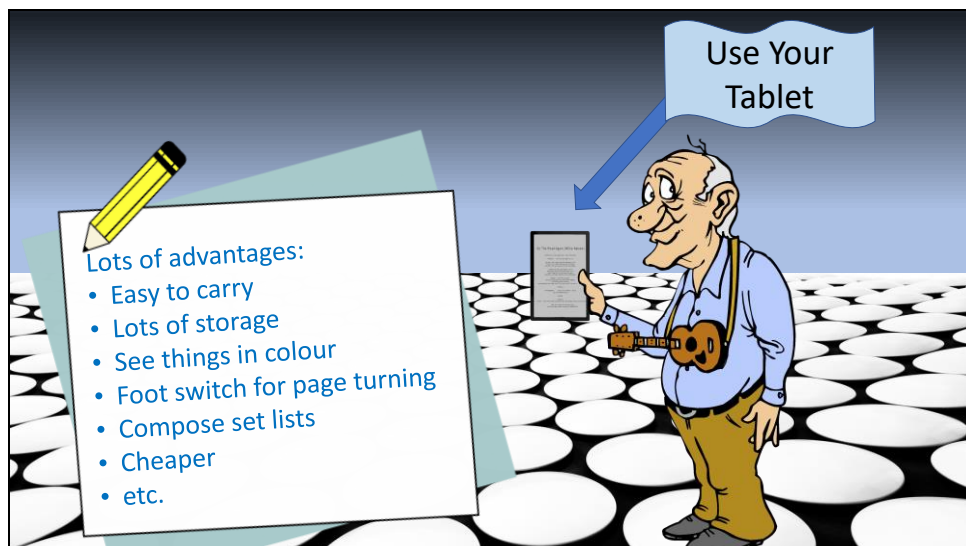

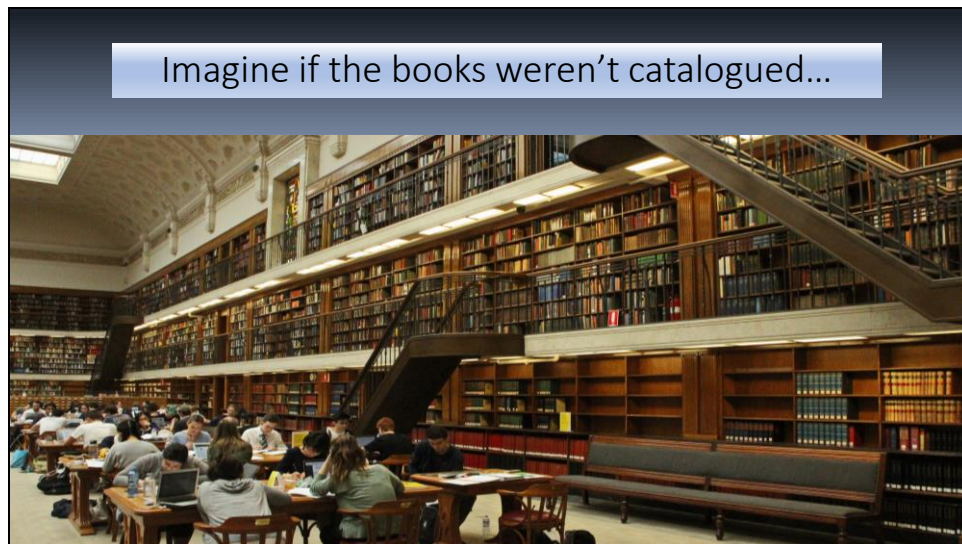
You could organise songs/books

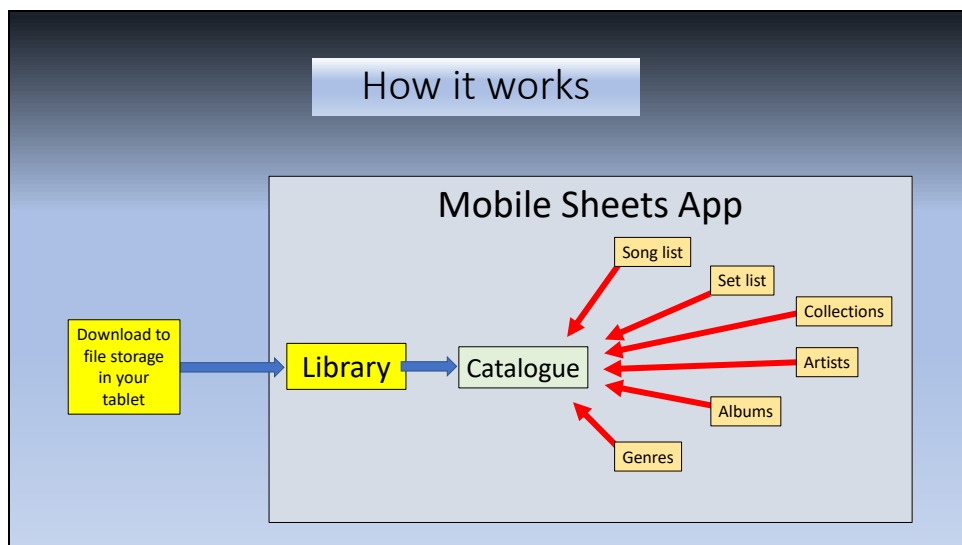

Where do you get it?

- Go To Google Play Store 
- Search for Mobilesheets
- There are two apps:
 - MobileSheets Trial. This version is free. It's designed to allow you to see what features are available and allow you to try it out. The limitation is that you can only catalogue a few songs.
 - MobileSheets Pro. This costs around \$13 and has all of the features, and allows for an unlimited number of songs.
 - IF YOU WISH, INSTALL THE FREE TRIAL VERSION FIRST AND SEE IF IT SUITS YOU.
 - You can upgrade to the Pro version later.
