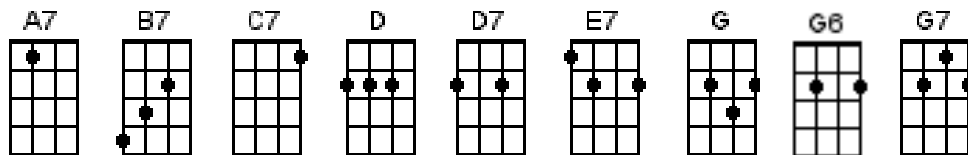


Bad, Bad Leroy Brown

 All the [D7 dD] men just [C7 dD] call him [G] "Sir" [D7]

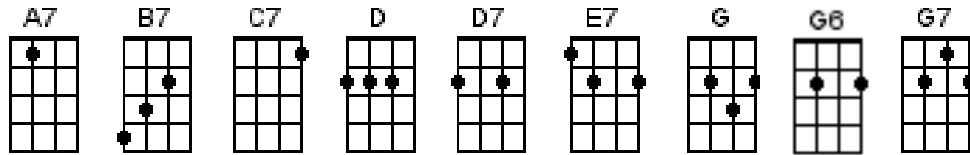
CHORUS
