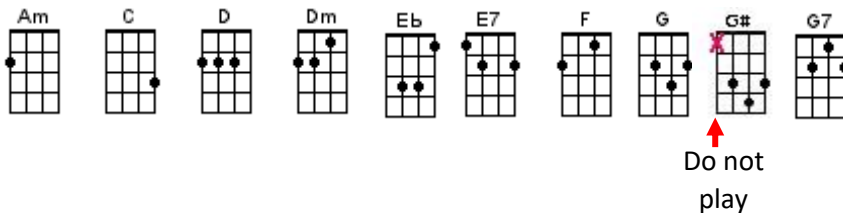


THE NEW AUSTRALIAN NATIONAL ANTHEM

In [Dm] joyful strains then [G7] let us sing ...

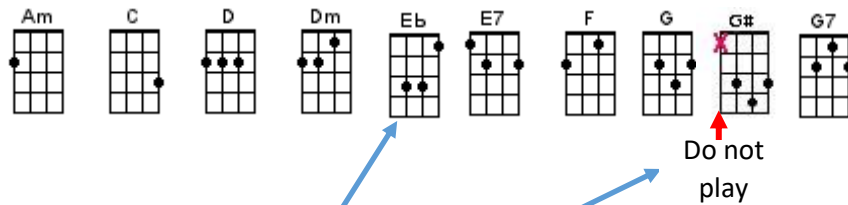
[G7] Skippy, the bush kanga-[C]roo
