C7 Dm

WOMEN C Am7 Dm7
He`s doin` dishes and baby clothes
G7 C C7 F
He`s so ambi-tious, he even sews
Fm C Am7 Dm7
MEN G7 C Cdim /// G7
Just don`t for-get folks, that`s what you get folks
ALL For makin` Whoopee.

ALL C Am7 Dm7
Another year or maybe less
G7 C C7 F
What`s this I hear? Well, can`t you guess
Fm C Am7 Dm7
She feels ne-glected and he`s sus-pected

WOMEN C Am7 Dm7
She sits alone most every night

ALL Dm7

ALL C7 Dm

MEN C7 Dm

Dm7 G7

WOMEN Dm7
Says you`ll give six to her.

MEN G7 C Am7 Dm7
He says “Now Judge, suppose I fail”

WOMEN G7 C Am7 Dm7
The judge says “Budge right into jail”
Fm C Am7 Dm7

ALL G7 C F Fm C
