The song was recorded by Israel Kamakawiwi'ole. Paula Fuga recorded the song on board the Hokule'a. The song was composed by George "Boogie" Kalama an original member of the crew, during the voyage. Makani means wind or air. Wikiwiki means quick or fast. Keala Tahiti means "The path to Tahiti".
